

# Positive Behavior Implementation Support

Positive Behavior Implementation Support (SW-PBIS) is a framework for creating safe and orderly learning environments in schools, while improving the social-emotional outcomes for students.



## PBIS relies on:

- Developing clear behavioral expectations
- Teaching these expectations
- Acknowledging appropriate behavior
- Consistently correcting inappropriate behavior
- Using behavioral data to systematically solve problems



## Settings and contexts addressed through PBIS:

- School-wide: instructional and noninstructional
- Individual Student Support
- Family: Engaging and supporting family participation

Timeline: 2 days of training

Teams may include teachers, paras, counselors and/or other support staff

*Each team must include an administrator*

Cost: \$895 per day per team (includes resource materials and ongoing technical support)
